Session-1 Details:

Dept. of Electrical & Electronics Engineering, AP IIIT-RGUKT, Nuzvid.

Session-1 Inauguration

The 'UI and UX Training' program was inaugurated on 20th November, 2019 by Dr. Y.Narasimha Rao, HoD, Dept. of CSE, QIS College of Engineering and Technology.

Dr. Y.Narasimha Rao has welcomed all dignitaries and delegates. In his welcome speech, he highlighted the importance and objectives of organizing this 'UI and UX Training' program. He introduced Mr. M Murali, the speaker of the session, to the participants.

On the first session, Mr. M Murali states that UX design refers to the term "user experience design", while UI stands for "user interface design". He said that both UX and UI elements are crucial to a product and work closely together. Despite these two elements have their professional relationship, referring to very different aspects of the product development process and the design discipline. He explained that a UX designer thinks about how the experience makes the user feel, and how easy it is for the user to accomplish their desired tasks. But a UI designer will think about icons and buttons, typography and color schemes, spacing, imagery, and responsive design etc. The speaker provide the significant information of both UI and UX to the participants. At the end, the session-1 was concluded with a vote of thanks given by Dr. Y.Narasimha Rao.

Session-2 Inauguration

The 'UI and UX Training' program was inaugurated on 20th November, 2019 by Dr. Y.Narasimha Rao, HoD, Dept. of CSE, QIS College of Engineering and Technology.

Dr. Y.Narasimha Rao has welcomed all dignitaries and delegates. In his welcome speech, he highlighted the importance and objectives of organizing this 'UI and UX Training' program. He introduced Mr. M Murali, the speaker of the session, to the participants.

On the second session, Dr. Jyothilal Nayak Bharothu explained that User experience (UX) design is the process design teams use to create products that provide meaningful and relevant experiences

The speaker mentioned that "UX Design" is often used interchangeably with terms such as "User Interface Design" and "Usability". However, while usability and user interface (UI) design are important aspects of UX design. He clearly provided the comparison of UX and UI elements. He discussed many points regarding UI and UX training and motivated the participants. At the end, the session-2 was concluded with a vote of thanks given by Dr. Y.Narasimha Rao.
